FUN SHOW RULES

Walk Jog and Junior Riders must be a minimum of 7 years old and not older than 18 years as of Jan 1, 2009.

Junior Riders must be 18 years or younger as of Jan 1, 2009.

Senior Riders must be a minimum of 19 years old as of Jan 1, 2009.

Lead-line Riders must be a minimum of 3 years old as of Jan 1, 2009

Lead-line and Walk Jog Riders may not cross enter.

All Riders less than 14 years of age as of Jan 1, 2009 will be required to wear a ASTM F1163 approved helmet. Any rider in any division may wear a helmet if they choose.

All Riders less than 18 years of age as of Jan 1, 2009 will be required to have parent or guardian sign their entry form.

Junior/Walk Jog/Lead-line riders may not show a Stallion in any class.

Clarkson Rodeo Days, Inc. is not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage of/to property of any kind. Shows will not be canceled except for lightning or arena conditions.

Proof of Negative Coggins (current 2008/2009) and current Rabies Vaccination is required for all horses.

All problems and/or complaints are to be addresses to the Show Representative only.

The Show Committee has the right to split, combine or change any classes without prior notice. Any unsafe, unruly or unsound horses will be excused.
